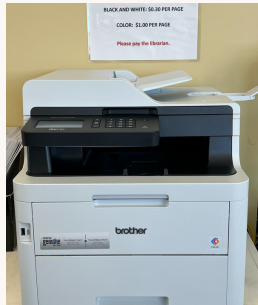

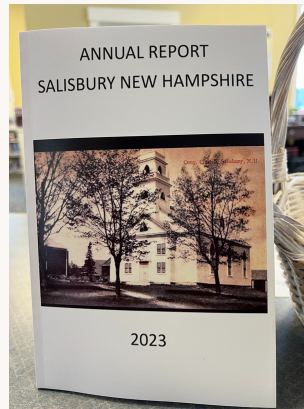


COFFEE STATION

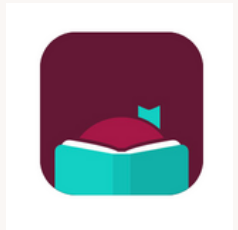
